New Meal Sharing Project Launched

At Food Train we are always looking at ways in which we can provide you, our members, with additional help and support. One of the topics mentioned many times over the years from our survey is how we would offer help with cooking. We are delighted to be able to announce the launch of an exciting new pilot project that does just that. Jointly funded by the Rank Foundation and the Scottish Government, our 2 year pilot project called Meal Makers aims to match up enthusiastic local people who can cook and share an extra portion of their home cooked food with an older person living nearby who is finding cooking difficult.

Sounds simple? It is! By using an innovative website, local volunteers can sign up to be cooks, going through a Disclosure check and a food hygiene test. Older people in need of support with meals are referred to the project by various agencies and then matched up to a local

cook. Our project team oversee the matches and follow up on the meal share arrangements. The website went live early August and the first meal share took place only 8 weeks later. Meal

Makers is only available in Dundee at the moment while we test it out, but will be coming to your local Food Train in the coming months so look out for more information in the future.








Food Train Renfrewshire recently celebrated their 1st birthday in style with cake and balloons during deliveries. Thanks
